Purpose of this Policy

In accordance with Bill 10 -2007 Section 2.2 and our established code of conduct for staff, volunteers and students, a person must not smoke or use tobacco, or hold lighted tobacco, including Vapour products, in or on school property at any time.

Procedures:

- 1. No Smoking signs will be displayed along the entrance to school property and at both entrances to the school building.
- 2. Staff, volunteers, families, and students will be informed of this policy and the subsequent consequences for being found in violation.
- 3. User groups who rent the school facility will be informed of the above-named policy and will sign an agreement to abide by it.
